





What is a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA)?

Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA's) are uniquely qualified to design and supervise Behavior Analytic therapy. They are certified by the global Behavior Analysis Certification Board after meeting educational, clinical supervision and testing requirements. ABC Center is the only center in Singapore where all children's programs are supervised by Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA's) with expertise in ABC's REAL technique.

We also work with experts in Speech-Language Pathology, Occupational Therapy and Educational Psychology to provide support.



We have helped thousands of children for over 30 years. We have expertise in Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy across a broad spectrum -- from low to high functioning autism, from infants to school-aged children, to teens and adults. We have both 1 on 1 and group programs, done in center or at home, in either English or Mandarin.

All children's programs are supervised by Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs).



What is it?

Play-based 1on1 ABA program for infants and toddlers.

Who is it for?

 Infants/toddlers below 3 years old, who exhibit symptoms of autism or developmental delay, at risk for a diagnosis of autism or who already have a diagnosis of autism.

How successful is it?

- If ABA is started at an early age, a significant number are able to attend regular school with same age peers.
- In line with 50 years of clinical data, 100% of children improve.

What does it teach?

- Skills such as communication, eye contact, play and responding to social reinforcement.
 - Learning is done via play-based stimuli appropriate for infant-toddlers.
 - Each child's program is individualized.





What is it?

10n1 ABA program for children 3 years and above

What does it teach?

- Language & Communication, Cognition, Social, Group and Play skills, Motor Skills, Early Literacy and Numeracy, Self-help and Independence.
- Reduction of negative or problematic behavior (eg tantrums, injurious behavior)
 - Every child's program is individualized.
 - Goal is to integrate into mainstream or SPED school

How successful is it

In line with 50 years of clinical data, 100% of children improve.

70% transitioned to mainstream/SPED school. Improvement seen in all skill domains:

- Language: 70+% reach Intermediate/Advanced Intraverbals, Listening and Linguistics
- Cognitive: 80+% reach Advanced Visual Perception and Pre-Academic Reading and Numeracy
- Social / Play: Almost 3x improvement in Social, Group and Play skills
- Motor: 80+% reach Intermediate/Advanced Pre-Academic Writing and Motor imitation
- Behavior: 100% show improvement





What is it?

Group based Early Intervention Preschool program for children with autism or learning difficulties.

Who is it for?

Children from 3 to 6 years old with special needs who are:

- ready to learn in a small group environment.
 - preparing for primary school.

How does it work?

- Children learn in pairs, or groups of 4-8 children.
 - Low staff: child ratio (1:2-3)
- Each child has an individualized education plan
 - Parents have a 7-week training program

What does it teach?

School readiness preparation within a Kindergarten curriculum.

Focused on language & communication, cognition & perception, basic reading, writing and numeracy, social / group and play, motor skills, self-help and independence.

Also focused on teaching appropriate classroom behavior.



What is it?

School Readiness Program assesses the child's readiness for target mainstream or SPED school, and prepares the child to succeed in it.

Classroom Shadowing provides a dedicated guide for the child in mainstream or SPED school.

Who is it for?

Children already planning for mainstrean or SPED school at kindergarten or primary level.

How does School Readiness work

- We assess the child's skill level to determine readiness for school.
- We discuss parent's target school options and help determine child's fit.
 - We teach detailed behaviors required in the target school, so that the child will be more prepared.

What is Classroom Shadowing

ABC's shadow teacher assists the child in navigating the school environment, understanding teacher instructions, and dealing with peers socially.





What is it?

A program to develop social intelligence, understanding of social cues and building social competency.

Who is it for?

- Children or teens who need to build positive social interactions.
- Those with Asperger's, high-functioning autism, ADHD, or other learning disabilities will benefit significantly.

What does it teach?

Social requirements such as

- dealing with parents and siblings
- proper response to teachers and other adults
 - socialization with peers in school
 - o understanding and handling of emotions





What is it?

A program focused on building independent daily living skills such as self-help, community living, leisure and pre-vocational skills.

Who is it for?

Teens and young adults who need to learn independence in daily living, effective functioning in the community and preparation for vocational skills.

How successful is it?

In line with 50 years of clinical data, 100% of individuals improve

What does it teach?

- The program is individualized for unique needs:

 home living independence such as self care and hygiene and household chores
- basic community living such as grocery shopping understanding money, riding the bus, and community leisure activities
 - pre-vocational skills in line with target vocation

It is rated by the Singapore Ministry of Health as Level 1++/ Grade A, the highest in evidence and recommendation.


Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA)

Systematically using positive rewards and fun, to motivate learning.

Taking meticulous data and analyzing each lesson to track progress.
